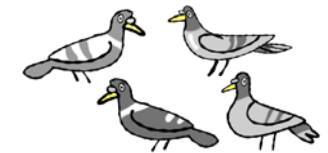
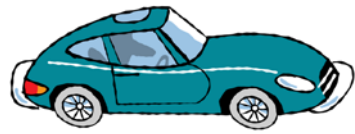




The bed looks like a rectangle
