





DO YOU HEAR THAT MEOWING?

Here, Kitty Kitty Come on let's play
















WHAT SHOULD WE DO? THERE'S NO SIMPLE

FIGURINES, AND CUPS. PROBLEM SOLVED!








WHAT TO DO?
