

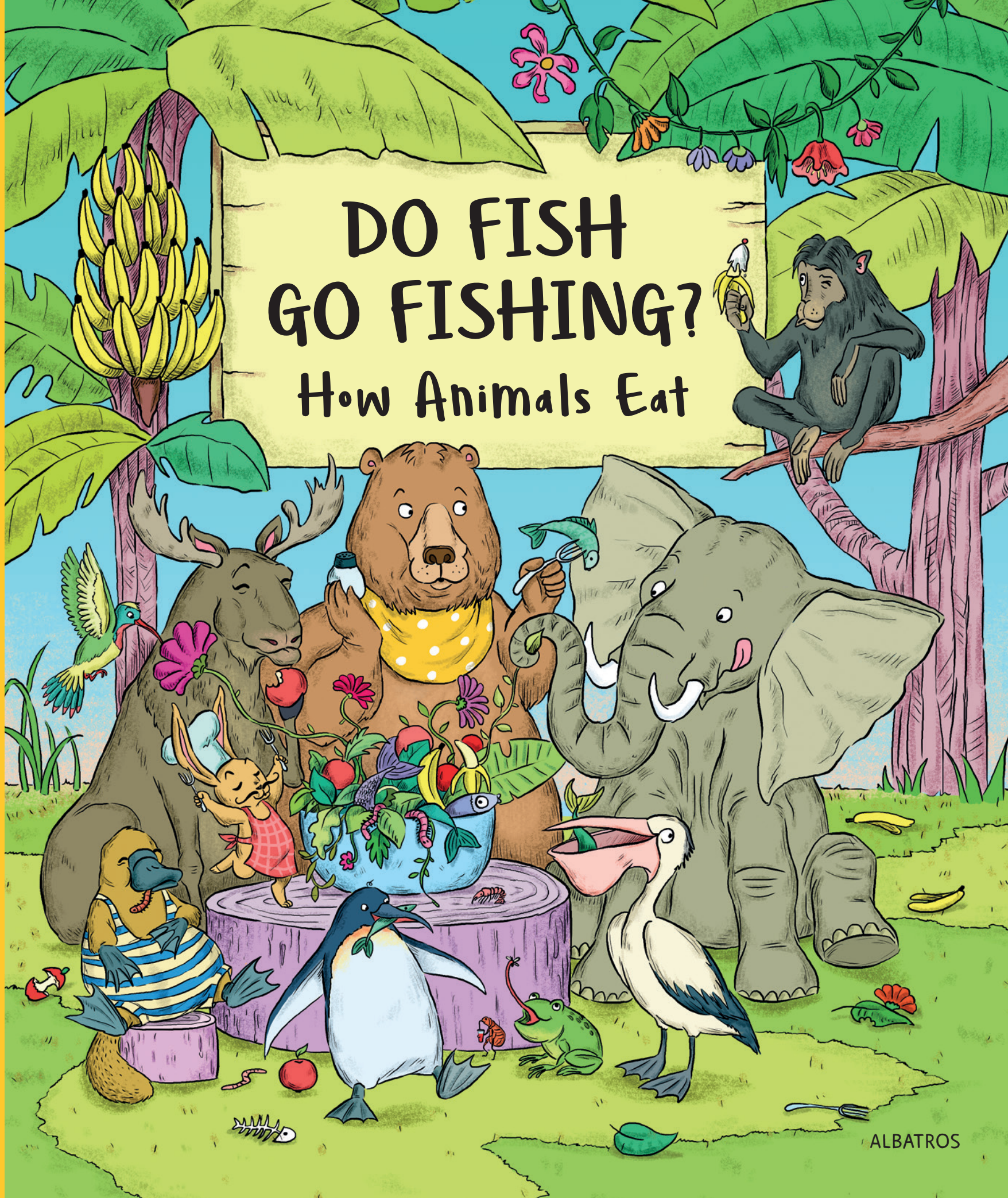

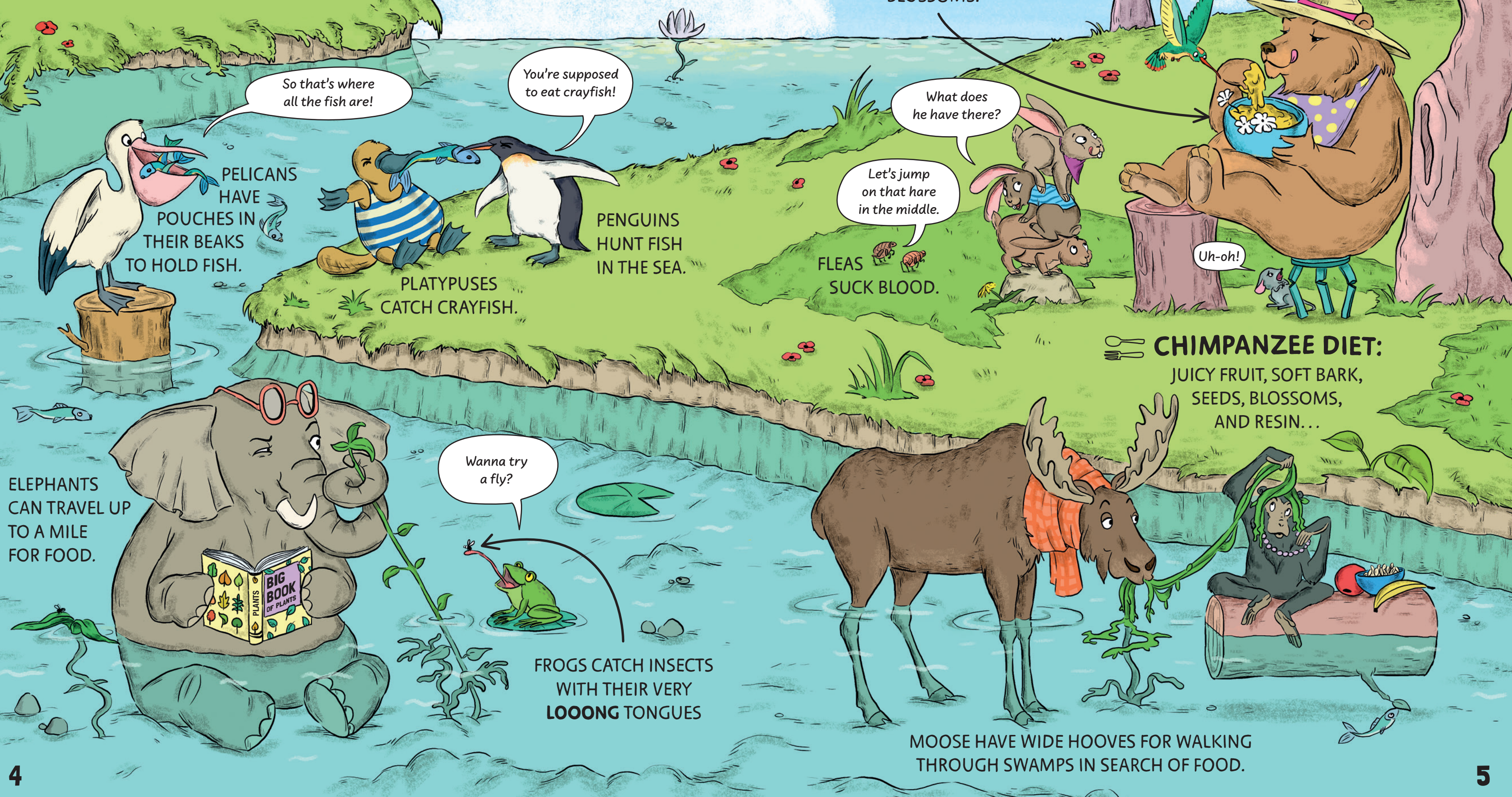


DO FISH GO FISHING? How Animals Eat

she dance to?



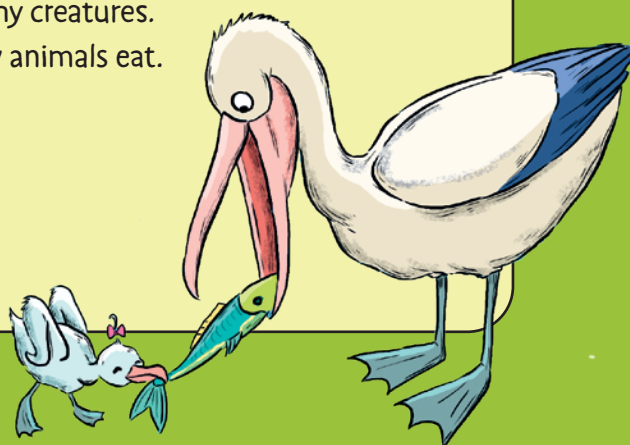

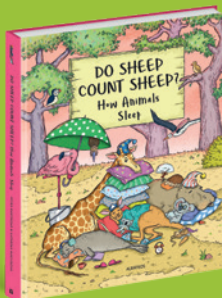
