




BOX CAMERA

Many modern cameras are so small that most of us have one in our cell phone. The first cameras were big cabinets. Not until the 20th century did cameras become smaller and better. Now we have reflex cameras where you can change the lenses, Polaroid cameras that print photos immediately, and palm-size digital cameras.





Depending on the camera, pictures are stored on film or on a digital memory card. Film is developed in a darkroom. Photos on a memory card can be viewed on the digital camera's display.


PHOTOGRAPHY CHANGES THE WORLD

Today's cameras are very easy to operate. Often, you just press a button and – *click* – the photo can be seen immediately.










WHY WE NEED **MUSEUMS**


HOW MUSEUMS DIFFER

While some museums are small, others are so large that you can get lost in them. Most museums specialize in a chosen area of human activity, while others focus on a single theme.





DIFFERENT HAIR, DIFFERENT ME



TOOLS FOR HAIRDRESSERS (AND OTHERS)




