when we started building.”




“Everyone has

except you.”



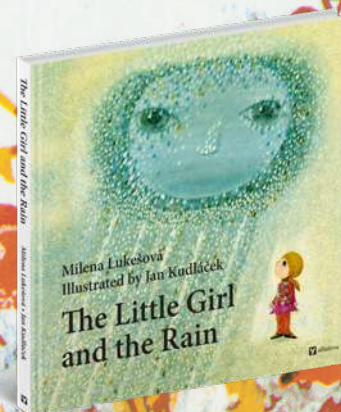
James would rather play with the girls, though.
