



Rita's grandpa got his wings and flew away too, just like my grandma. That was a long time ago. I was really little so I didn't get to see it happen.









The birdhouses are for Manuel's grandma, whose name is Mila. She has a ton of birds: Danny, Chicklet, Lily...

Then she plays the violin for a little while and they fall asleep.






